Summary of Selected Workforce Data FY 2010**

Turnover and Vacancy Rates:

Total Nursing (LPNs, RNs, APRNs) Turnover

The overall turnover rate for nurses increased from 15.1% in FY 2009 to 18.8% in FY 2010. **Sixteen districts reported turnover rates in the double digits for FY 2010!**

Total Nursing (LPNs, RNs, APRNs) Vacancy

The overall vacancy rate for nurses increased from 16.3% in FY 2009 to 19.2% in FY 2010. **Fourteen districts reported vacancy rates in the double digits for FY 2010!**

Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs) Turnover

The turnover rate for APRNs increased from 14.5% in FY 2009 to 20.3% in FY 2010. **Thirteen districts reported turnover rates in the double digits for FY 2010!**

Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs) Vacancy

The vacancy rate for APRNs increased from 15.8% in FY 2009 to 22.7% in FY 2010. **Thirteen districts reported vacancy rates in the double digits for FY 2010!**

Nursing Classification:

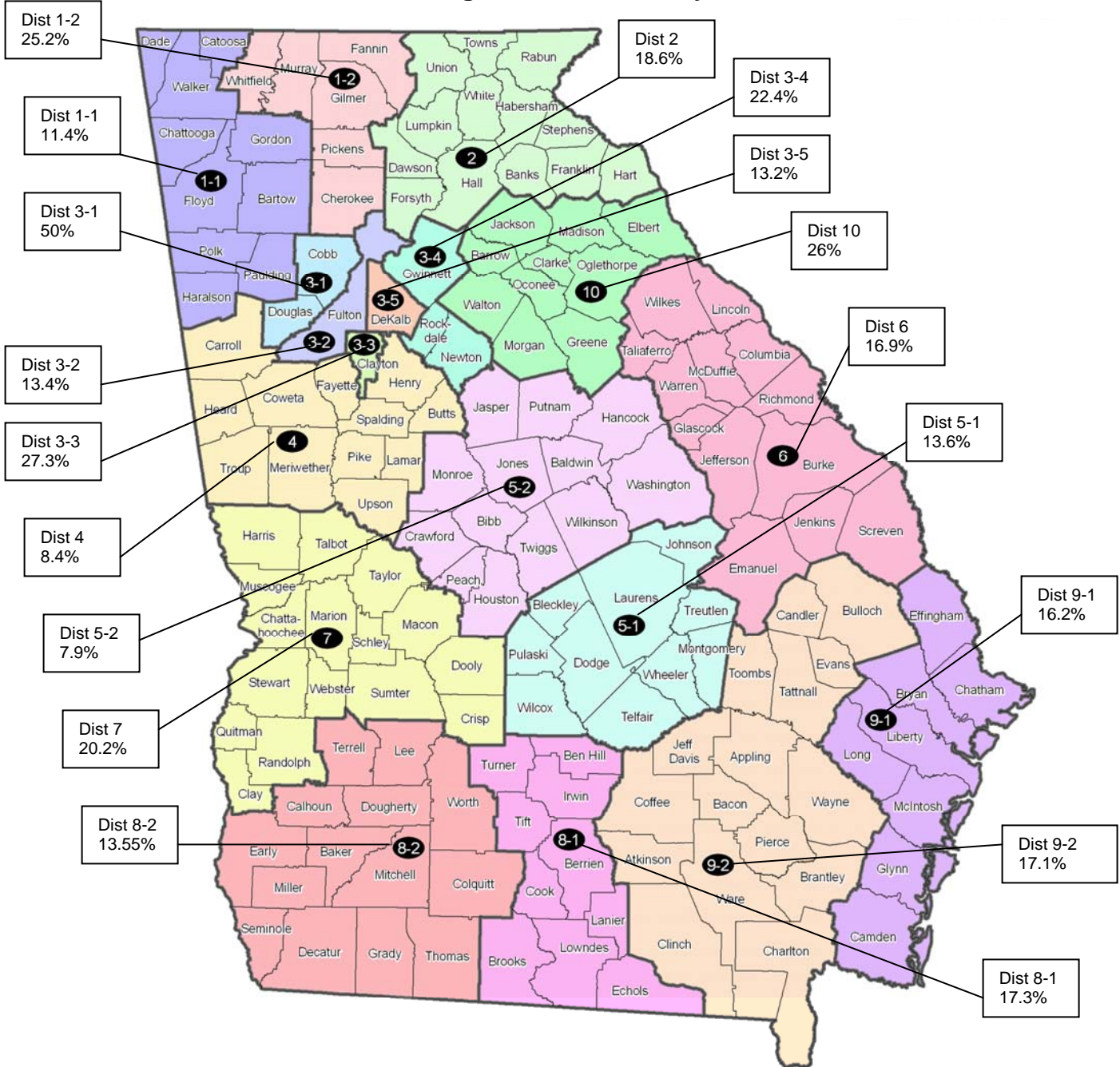
The total number of Public Health Nurses in Georgia increased by less than two from 1422.9 in FY 2009 to 1424.2 in FY 2010. The total number of LPNs increased from 265.9 in FY 2009 to 271.4 in FY 2010. The total number of RNs decreased by one from 1014 in FY 2009 to 1013 in FY 2010. The number of APRNs decreased from 143 in FY 2009 to 139.8 in FY 2010.

Nursing Education:

Of the total 1152.8 RNs and APRNs for FY 2010, 633.2 (54.9%) have a BSN or higher degree.
