INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT)

Division of Information Technology

DHP Office of Information Technology (OIT) consists of approximately 110 people who support five areas, to include

1. Applications Development
2. Information Technology Services
3. Vital Records
4. Project Management
5. Information Security

The Applications Development staff maintains two major applications,

- one that provides statewide disease surveillance and notification and
- another that supports multiple DPH programs ranging from Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) nutrition program, to Family Planning, to Women's Health.

Information Technology Services manages end-user-computer services and wide area network support for that State Office and helps all 18 DPH Health Districts with various IT issues such as broadband and internet services.

Other programs

- The Office of Vital Records is the official state registrar for births, deaths, divorces, fetal deaths, and induced termination of pregnancies throughout Georgia.
- The Project Management Office (PMO) oversees major technology projects by providing Project Managers and Business Analyst.
- The PMO ensure projects are completed on time, on budget, and meet all program business requirements.
